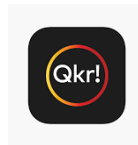


Roleystone Community College Payment Options

Online Payments (Netbank)

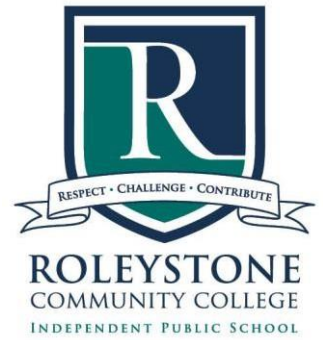
Parents can also pay by Netbank – details as follows:

College APP



Parents and Caregivers can also keep up to date with information and news from the College by using our College APP, which you can access through the APP store on your mobile device, by searching for Schoolzine App.

The app links to the school events calendar, current newsletter, RCC website, frequently used forms and allows parents to send in their child's absentees.

Short Message Service (SMS) for Absentees

Roleystone Community College also uses the Short Message Service system that notifies parents/guardians/caregivers via a text message to a mobile phone of an unexplained absence or late arrival of their child/children.

SMS may also be used to provide information to parents/guardians/caregivers such as school community notices and emergency/unplanned events such as school closures.

If your child is absent and a reason has been provided before the time the SMS is due to be sent, you will not receive a text message.

Connect



Connect is an integrated online environment developed by the Department of Education WA for staff, students and parents in public schools.

Parents of children within the college are able to use Connect to get information and updates directly from the teachers of their children, and also have an interface to send messages directly back to the teacher. Please note however, we would expect teachers to respond within a reasonable period of time (usually about 24 hours).

Parents of all children will be able to see an up to date overview of their child's attendance at the college.

You will also have an archive of all of your child's school reports. This is the only method of report distribution.
