

Mobile Phone Policy 2020

The policy is in line with all other public schools and for our school, there are minimal changes.

The rules for Mobile Phones are outlined by the phrase, “**Not seen or heard**” and includes headphones, earbuds and smart watches.

For primary students... Students must present their phone to the front office as they enter the school and collect at the end of each day. We ask students to do this in a pencil case or similar with their name clearly labelled to avoid confusion when returning phones.

For secondary students... Students may keep their phones on their person but should not be seen or heard. This is from the time they enter the college site and ends when they leave the site. Students whose phones are seen or heard will have their phone confiscated and sent to the front office.

After the first or second instance of this occurring, students will need to collect their phone at the end of the day. If there is a third instance, parents will be required to collect the phone from administration. Students who do not comply with the request from a staff member for their phone to be confiscated will be suspended from school for a breach of our behaviour code.
